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1. Qualitative Information on Financial Results for the Current Quarter

(1) Qualitative information regarding the status of consolidated business results

During the three months started from Apr.1, 2021, world economy has been under sever condition and uncertainty about futures remained which influenced by pandemic of COVID-19, also in Japan, economic activities have been forced to be restricted.

In each business area which we belong to, for example in mechatronics related business, because of expanded needs for 5G and Ai and expanded demand for data center use leaded by progress of IoT and DX, business has continued to be well. In the other related business, business resulted very severe because of restricted people flow caused by COVID-19. As a result, our consolidated business result of this three months period ended Jun 30, 2021,were net sales of ¥4,748 million (10.1% decreased compared to the corresponding period of the previous year), operating income of ¥122 million (the corresponding period of the previous year was minus ¥1 million), ordinary income of ¥117 million (1,001,1% increased compared to the corresponding period of the previous year), profit attributable to owners of parent of ¥32 million (the corresponding period of the previous financial year was minus ¥23 million). Due to the adoption of Revenue Recognition Accounting Standards etc, sales for the first quarter of this financial year decreased by ¥124 million, cost of sales decreased by ¥77 million, and operating income, ordinary income, net income before taxes decreased by ¥46 million each. In addition, the balance of retained earnings at the beginning of the period increased by ¥46 million.

Each segment result was as follows.

(Mechatronics related business)

Taping equipment for electronic components and automobile semiconductor, semiconductor for datacenter and power semiconductor related business went well because of strong demand. As a result of these, sales of Mechatronics related business were ¥2,874 million (17.2% increased compared to the corresponding period of the previous year) and segment profit was ¥383 million (210.7% increased compared to the corresponding period of the previous year). (Display related business)

In P.R.C. which is a main manufacturing market, manufacturing plan have delayed because of city lockdown and restricted people flow, and business went sluggish.

As a result, sales of Display related business were ¥344 million (69.7% decreased compared to the corresponding period of the previous year) and segment profit was minus ¥238 million (the corresponding period of the previous year was minus ¥138 million). Due to the adoption of Revenue Recognition Accounting Standards etc, sales for the first quarter of this financial year decreased by ¥124 million and segment income decreased by ¥46 million. (Industrial machinery related business)

Domestic and overseas market has been influenced by changes of life-style such as self-restrain and increasing tele-work caused by state of emergency issued, and business atmosphere in domestic as well as overseas were very severe.

As a result, sales of Industrial machine related business were ¥127 million (42.8% decreased compared to the corresponding period of the previous year) and segment profit was minus ¥60 million (the corresponding period of the previous year was minus ¥47 million).

(Electronics related business)

Never the less the sales of control communication equipment went well but bid for dialyzer in Latin America delayed and resulted below budget.

As a result, sales of Electronics related business were ¥1,402 million (4.5% decreased compared to the corresponding period of the previous year) and segment profit was minus ¥7 million (the corresponding period of the previous year was ¥1 million).

(2) Qualitative information regarding changes in consolidated financial position

(Assets)

Total assets as of Jun 30, 2021 were ¥35,103 million, a decrease of ¥2,405 million compared

to the previous financial year end. In current assets, this is mainly due to a decrease ¥1,890 million in cash and deposit and ¥ 1,078 million in trade note and account receivable.

Noncurrent assets were ¥8,320 million a decrease of ¥20 million compared to the previous financial year end.

(Liabilities)

Total liabilities as of Jun. 30, 2021 were ¥20,917 million, a decrease of ¥2,465 million compared to the previous financial year end. The major decrease were ¥2,069 million in short-term loans payable and ¥463 million in long-term loans payable. (Net assets)

Total net assets as of Jun. 30, 2021 were ¥14,185million, an increase of ¥60 million compared to the previous financial year end. As a result, equity ratio as of Jun 30, 2021 was 40.3% (the previous financial year end was 37.5 %)

(3) Qualitative information regarding consolidated business results and dividends forecast

Consolidated twelve months business result forecasts ending at Mar.31, 2022 and cash dividend forecast remain the same as consolidated business results and dividend forecast which announced on May. 14, 2021.

<Adoption of "Accounting Standard for Revenue Recognition," etc.>

The Company has adopted the "Accounting Standard for Revenue Recognition" (ASBJ Statement No. 29, March 31, 2020 (hereinafter "Accounting Standard for Revenue Recognition". from the beginning of the first quarter of fiscal year of 2022 and recognizes revenue for goods or services based on the amount estimated to be received in exchange for such goods or services at the point when control of the promised goods or services is transferred to the customer.

As a result, in case of export sales which the Group is obliged to install in contracts with customers, in the past domestic consolidated subsidiaries used to recognize revenue when we received an acceptance from a customer, but now we will be obliged to recognize "delivery of equipment" and "Installation and on-site adjustment work" as a separate and independent performance obligation. We have changed to a method of recognizing each revenue when the delivery of the equipment is completed and when the installation adjustment on site is completed. However, we apply the method stipulated in Article 84 of the Accounting Standard for Revenue Recognition. Therefore, we have not retroactively applied the new accounting policy to previous handled contracts that recognized almost all revenue amounts prior to the beginning of the first quarter of this consolidated fiscal period. As a result, net sales for the first quarter of the current consolidated cumulative period decreased by ¥124 million, cost of sales decreased by ¥77 million, and operating income, ordinary income, and net income before adjustment for taxes decreased by ¥46 million each. In addition, the balance of retained earnings at the beginning of the current period has increased by ¥46 million.

In accordance with the transition provisions in Article 89-2 of the Accounting Standard for Revenue Recognition, the Company has not reclassified financial statements for the previous fiscal year by using the new presentation method. Furthermore, in accordance with the transitional treatment stipulated in "Accounting Standards for Quarterly Financial Statements" (Corporate Accounting Standard No. 12, March 31, 2020), paragraphs 28-15, we have not stated the profits generated from the contracts with customers for the previous first quarter consolidated cumulative period.

<Adoption of "Accounting Standard for Fair Value Measurement," etc.>

The Company has adopted the "Accounting Standard for Fair Value Measurement" (ASBJ Statement No. 30, July 4, 2019 (hereinafter "Accounting Standard for Fair Value Measurement") from the beginning of the first quarter of fiscal year of 2022. The Company has prospectively adopted new accounting policies based on the Accounting Standard for Fair Value Measurement, etc. in accordance with the transition provisions in Article 19 of Accounting Standard for Fair Value Measurement and Article 44-2 of "Accounting Standard for Financial Instruments" (ASBJ Statement No.10, July 4, 2019). There is no impact of these changes on quarterly financial statements.

As described in the change in accounting policy, Accounting Standard for the Revenue Recognition, etc. will be adopted from the beginning of the first quarter of this consolidated accounting period. Due to the change in the accounting method for revenue recognition, the method for measuring profit or loss in the business segment has also changed.

As a result of this change, sales of the "display-related business" decreased by 124 million yen and segment income decreased by 46 million yen compared to the conventional method.
